

ABOUT CHAMBER MUSIC METROWEST

Chamber Music MetroWest is an organization that seeks to bring chamber music to life for the Metrowest Boston community by providing accessible and affordable high-caliber concerts and educational programs. This mission is founded on the belief that music has a remarkable power to bring positive change to a community by educating, entertaining, uplifting and inspiring.

Chamber Music MetroWest began in 2012 with an Inaugural concert in Marlborough, followed soon after (in early 2013) by a clinic at Marlborough High School, a concert at Marlborough Senior Center and our first children's concert. Since that time, we have performed yearly concerts at Marlborough Senior Center and twice yearly children's concerts at David French Music Company in Westborough. Both the Senior Center concerts and the children's concerts are presented free of charge so that financial concerns do not impact attendance.

CMMW activities have been funded so far through grants, sponsorships from local businesses and donations from the musicians. For our children's concerts, we've been fortunate to receive 3 grants from the Westborough Cultural Council and 1 grant from the Northborough Cultural Council. These types of funding, however, cannot be taken for granted, and so we are working to make our programming activities more sustainable. This is where we need your help.

Our expenses fall into the following categories: musician compensation for rehearsals and performance, sheet music purchase, marketing of our concerts, program printing, equipment rental for concerts and supplies.

Our work depends upon outside financial help to fund our work in the MetroWest community. Please consider helping us make our efforts sustainable so that we can continue our current projects and eventually expand our activities so that we can reach more people.
